OUTCOME:

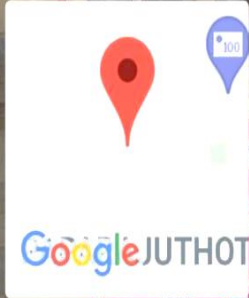
Through this programme students came to know about the achievements, history, and significance of Savitribai Phule in shaping women's education as well as other social reforms in India.

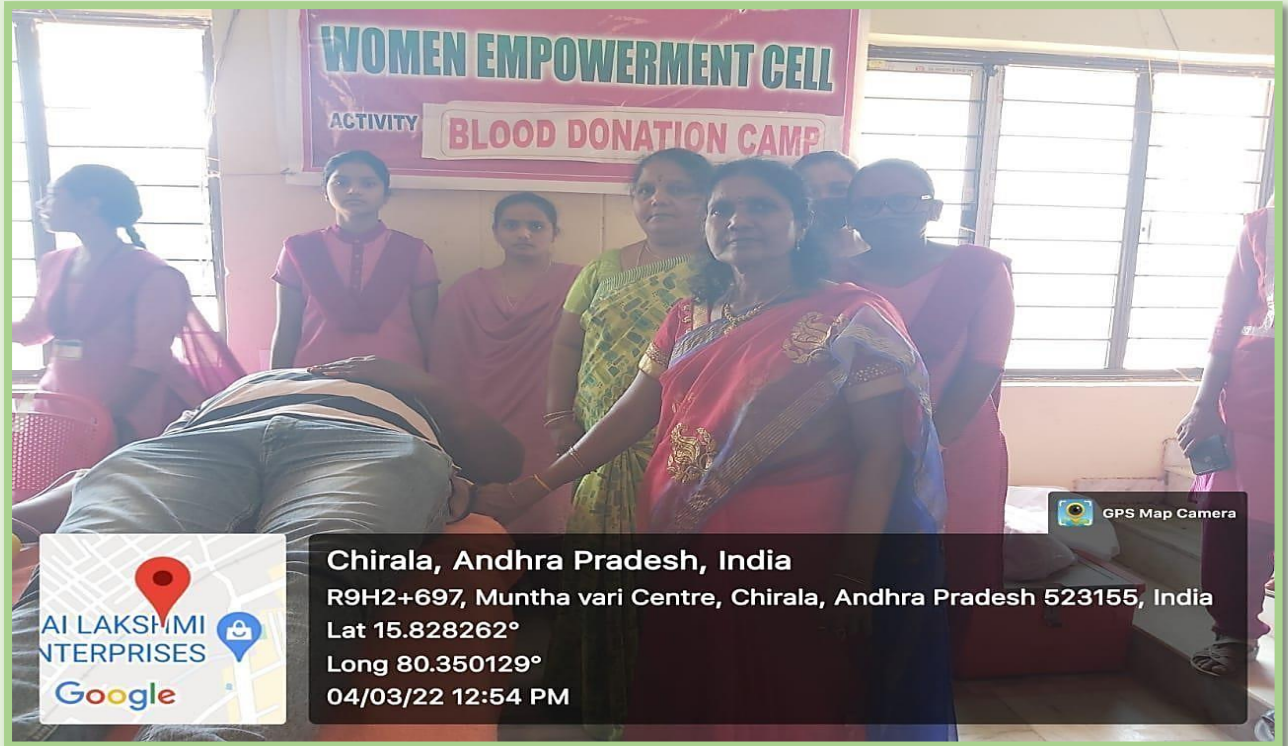
DESCRIPTION:

Since blood cannot be manufactured outside the body and has a limited shelf life, the supply must constantly be replenished by generous blood donors. 117 students participated and donated blood in the camp.

Objectives:

Create awareness about equality in social system, democratic activities and legal aspects of gender equity.

Description:

The Women Empowerment Cell organized a workshop on “Gender Sensitization” on 11.05.2022 for creating awareness among the women employees of our Institute and students. The workshop was inaugurated by Dr.Ch.Ramanamma, Principal of this college and Smt. M. Bhagya Lakshmi Women Empowerment Cell Coordinator, other staff members and students participated. The Principal guided the students on various kinds of harassment against women with examples through video clips.

The workshop was divided into two sessions. In the first session a lecture demonstration was conducted by Sri.M.V.Chalapathi Rao, Advocate, Chirala on Gender Sensitization in various modules. In the afternoon session Dr. Ch. Ramanamma, Principal talked about Patriarchy, violence in the family as well as issues related to gender inequality in the society.
