CODE OF ETHICS TO CHECK MALPRACTICES OF PLAGIARISM IN RESEARCH PUBLICATIONS

- Authors/research scholars must preserve originality and fidelity in their articles
- Either intentionally or unintentionally done, plagiarism leads to infringement of copy right act and it is punishable
- There is a lot of software available to check the plagiarism related malpractices
- Authors/researchers are responsible for language editing before submitting the article
- It is advisable to credit and refer to any work or words taken from other authors or contributors
- By paraphrasing, summarizing, citing/quoting the text in inverted commas and also finally by referring to the source of the original in the bibliography and acknowledging the source will avoid malpractices related to plagiarism.
