## HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

The much neglected women education in India was seriously considered and given the needed attention only from Independence. According to Mahatma Gandhi "It is possible to bring dignity to women and to enhance their life span, only by educating them".

Realizing the importance of building a strong society, the philanthropists and eminent educationists of Chirala town came forward to start a college for Women, first of its kind in Prakasam District.

The college was started with the generous funds provided by the Yarlagadda Ramanadha Babu Charity Trust, in the name of Yarlagadda Annapurnamba. Hence this government college is named after Yarlagadda Annapurnamba.

Yarlagadda Annapurnamba Govt. College for Women, Chirala, was started on 15<sup>th</sup> August, 1966 as a composite college to cater to the educational needs of women students of the area, especially the downtrodden. The college has got its own land of 7.5 acres and the built-up area is about 65340 Sq.ft. The college is located in the heart of the town, very near to the Railway station as well as the APSRTC bus station.

The main aim of the college is to educate women and make them self-reliant and empower them in all walks of life. In the year 2002 the composite college was bifurcated as Y.A. Govt. Degree College for Women and Y.A. Govt. Junior College for Women.

The college is affiliated to Acharya Nagarjuna University, Guntur.

The college has been recognised by UGC under 2(f) & 12(b) it was accredited by NAAC with "B" grade in 2008 under cycle 1. Again it was accredited by NAAC, Bangalore under cycle 2 with "B" grade with 2.71 CGPA.

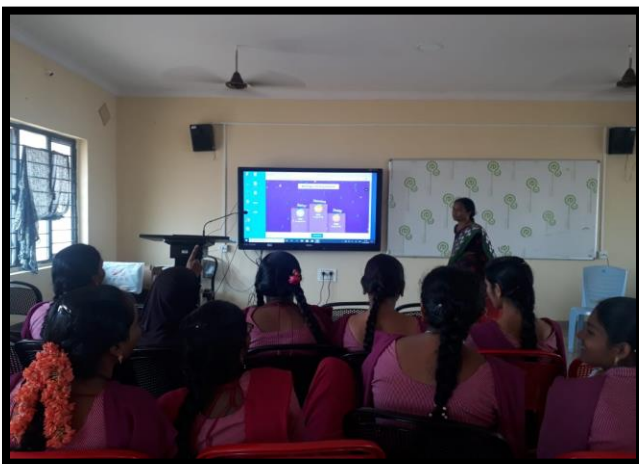

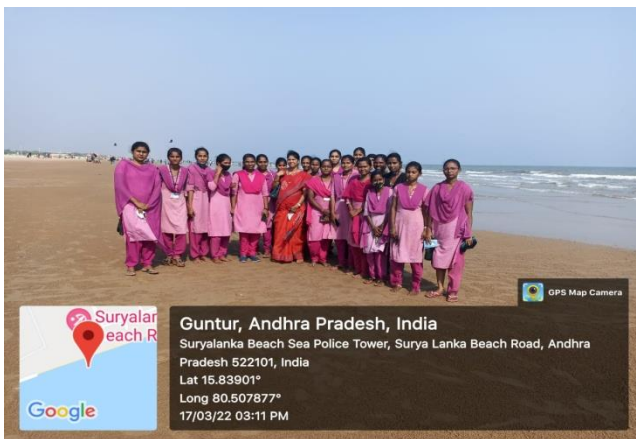
