

been offering only UG Programmes leading to BA, B.Com. and B.Sc. Degree. Though the college is recognized by the UGC under 2f and 12B of the act, it has not obtained any grants for research projects. The Peer Team observes that the college has initiated steps to improve and sustain quality in its activities and has oriented itself towards the cause of education and advancement of the physical and mental interest of the students through Science, Arts and Commerce education. The college involves itself in a number of activities to fulfill its definite goals.

The Peer Team makes the following recommendation for the consideration of the college.

Recommendations:

1. College may introduce Postgraduate courses and Vocational and Add-on Courses as part of Development strategy. Courses with different combinations could be introduced, e.g. Biotechnology, Tourism Management. Intake for the existing popular courses may be increased to meet the growing demand.
2. Seminars, Workshops, Conference etc., may be conducted to widen the scope of education of the learners
3. More number of remedial classes and bridge courses may be arranged to help the weak students.
4. Teachers may be motivated to take up research work as no Ph.D. holders are available in the college.
5. Support services may be strengthened so as to equip the students appearing for competitive examinations and for those seeking employment.
6. More number of computers may be provided for the use of the students and Departments.
7. Library may be computerized and interlibrary borrowing facility may be made available. UGC Inlibnet services may be obtained.

8. Computer aided and modern teaching aids need to be provided to strengthen teaching-learning process.
9. Tutorial system need be strengthened by introducing effective mechanism for quality checks and attendance.
10. College may seriously think about undertaking more extension activities to expand the horizon of knowledge of the students.
11. Computer literacy programmes may be made compulsory to all students.
12. Activities of the Alumni association may be coordinated and strengthened in order to boost developmental activities of the college.
13. Special programmes and projects for the Women empowerment have to be given priority by the college. Special Assistance in this regard could be sought from UGC. Co curricular activities which help confidence building among women students need be given more importance.
14. Hostel facilities may be provided to the needy students.
15. National and International linkages for teaching and research may be explored by the College. Financial assistance by UGC for lady researchers could be explored.
16. Linkage with industries and institutes run by Women entrepreneurs may be established for creating employment opportunity for the students.
17. Parent –Teacher meeting may be made a regular activity in the College.
- ✓18. Language laboratory for spoken English can be envisaged.
19. Through interactions with the stake-holders, it is felt that there is a need to change the medium of instruction from Telugu to English.

The Peer Team is of the best belief that this exercise will be useful to the institution to initiate quality enhancement strategies. The Peer Team also records its appreciation for the cooperation and support extended to it by the Principal and other constituents of the college.
