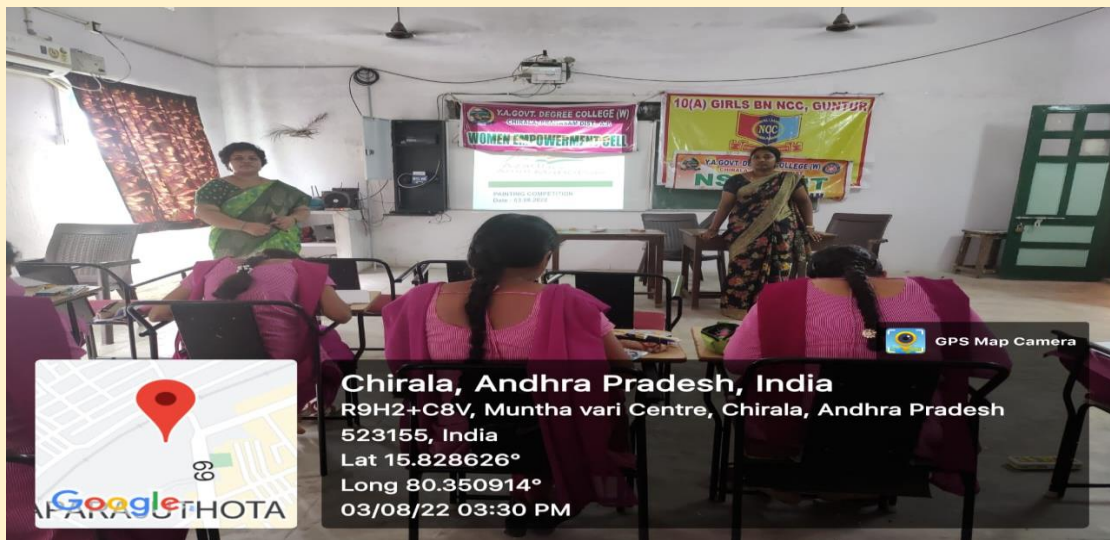

Outcomes:

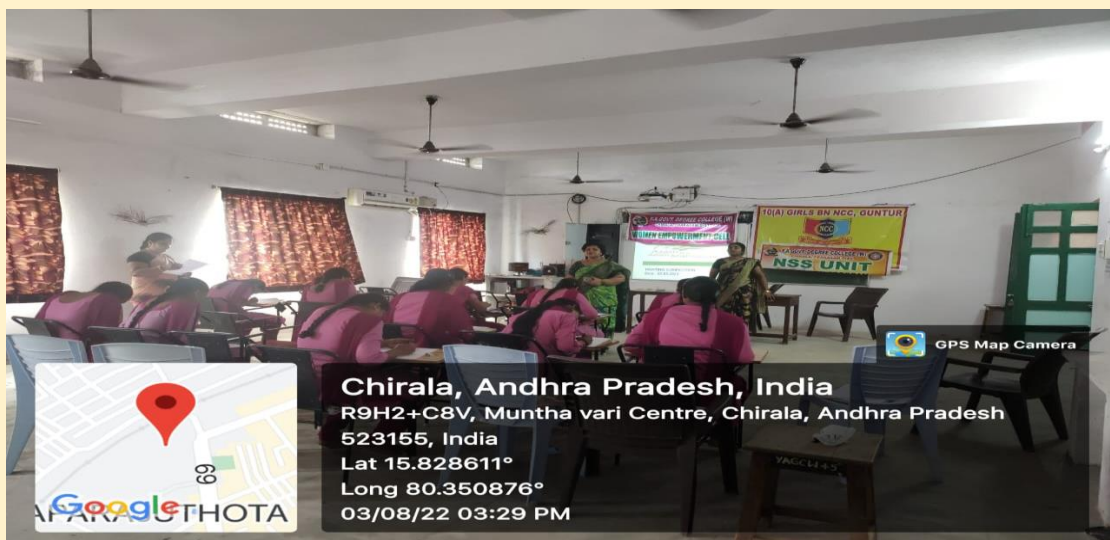
- ❖ Through this program students came to know about the need of freedom to India, history of the freedom movement, and the significance of freedom fighters to achieve the freedom to the India.

- ❖ To give suggestions to protect themselves in the case of any problems.

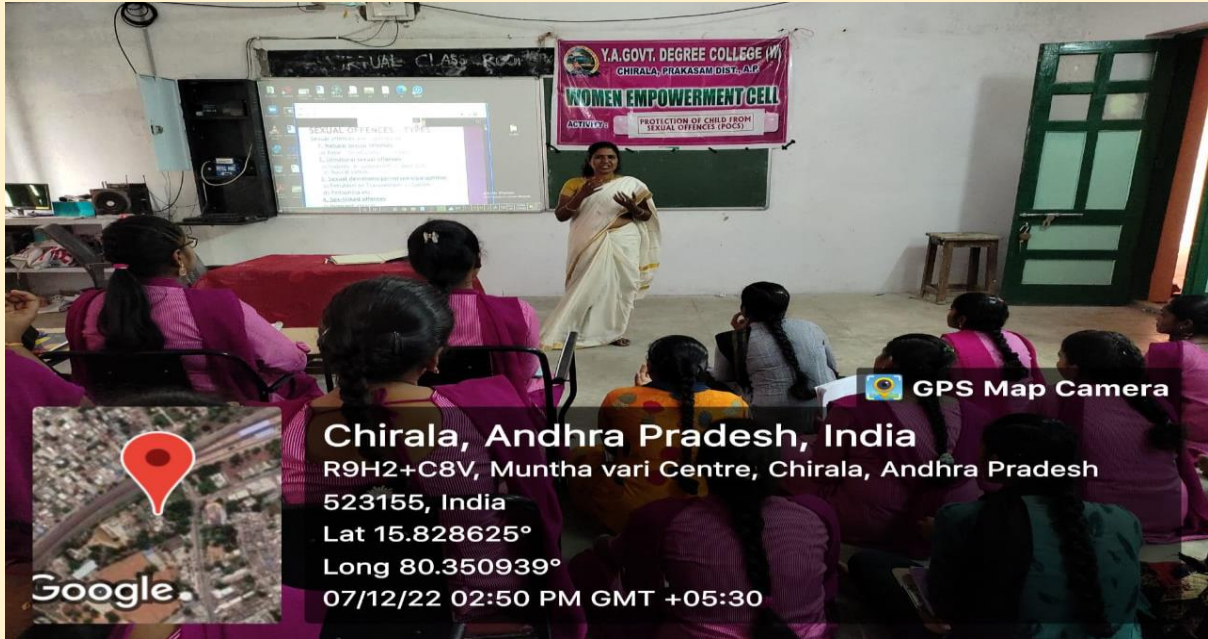
Description:

No. of Participants: 54

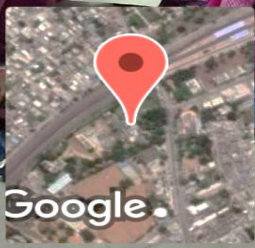
Outcome:

A free medical camp was organized with the aegis of Ayush Doctors, Chirala. Doctors from Ayush Department Dr. Ashok Kiran and team, Aayush Homeo Clinic, Chirala are participated in the program. The guests spoke about the need of taking nutritious food and keeping our body fit and healthy examined the students. Vitamin supplements, calcium supplements and folic acid with iron tablets and syrups were given to them. The total cost of the tablets was about Rs. 10,000/-.
