Activity Name: Awareness Program on Leprosy and Cancer

Date: 28-11-2019

Aims & Objectives:

- ❖ To create awareness about leprosy's incidence, spread, and impact.
- ❖ To create awareness about the impact of tobacco consumption and smoking on health.

Description: The WEC, in collaboration with National Tobacco Control Program, Prakasam District, Organized an orientation workshop and Leprosy awareness program. Dr. Ch. Ramanamma, principal, presided over the meeting and spoke about the various social, physical, mental, psychological, and emotional consequences for an individual affected by leprosy. Sri L. Joseph, District Health Education Officer, stressed the need to create a free, leprosy world for future generations. He explained the symptoms of leprosy and measures to prevent the incidence of leprosy. He also explained how to recognize whether a patch on the skin is a symptom of leprosy or not. Sri. N. Sarangapani, Deputy Para Medical Officer, spoke about the mental trauma experienced by the persons affected by leprosy. He told the audience to treat the leprosy patients with sympathy and kindness.

Social Worker Smt. P. Sujatha from Tobacco Control Program, Ongole, spoke about the horrible consequences of consuming tobacco products and smoking. She explained that tobacco use is one of the significant causes of cancer. She advised the students to abstain from consuming tobacco products in any form. WEC Convener, Dr. D. Dhatri Kumari coordinated the program. WEC members Smt. B.Sravani, Smt. Sk. Gousia and other Lecturers participated in this program.
