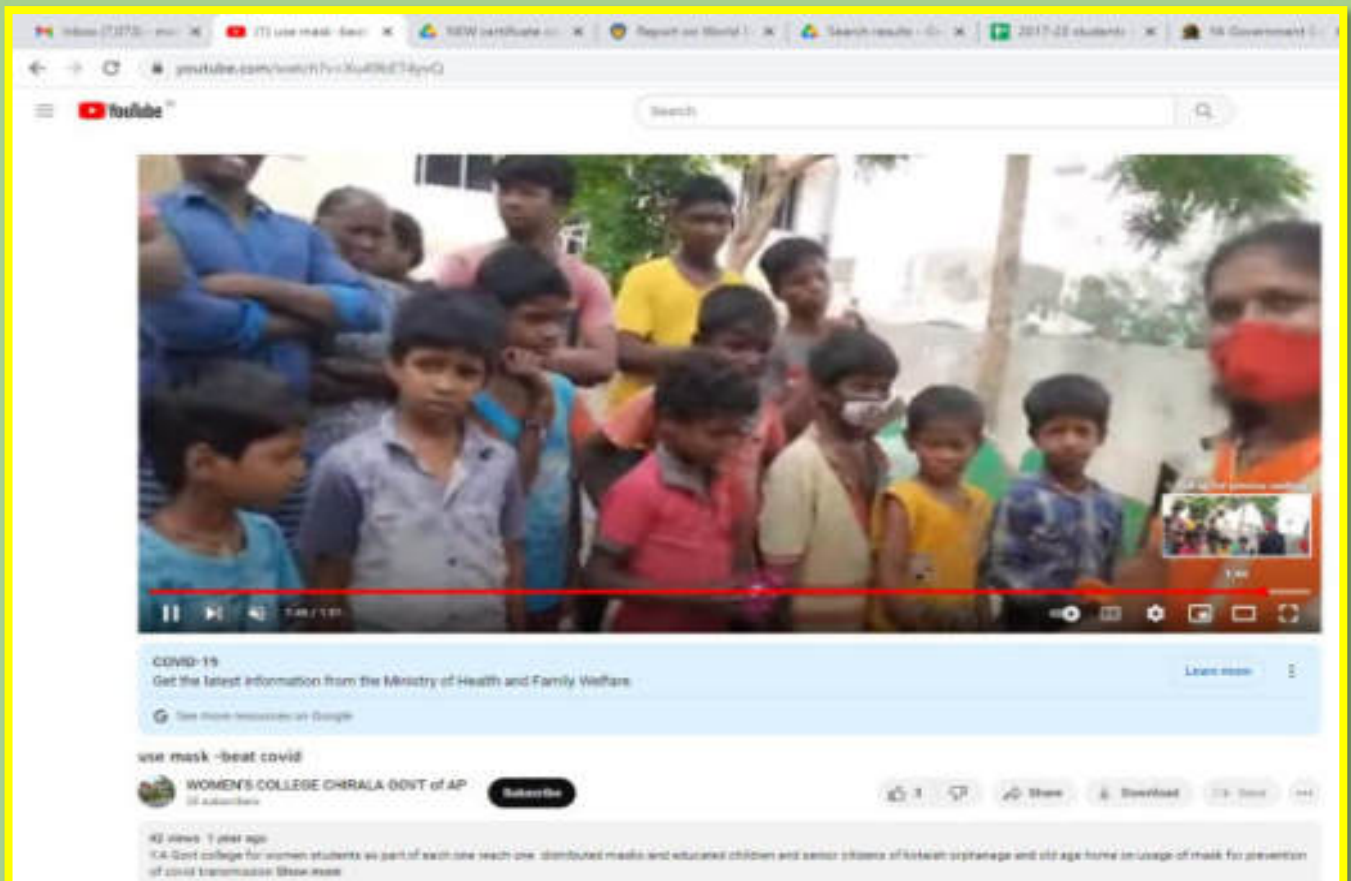

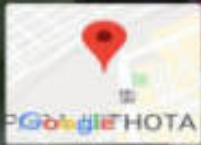

Objective:

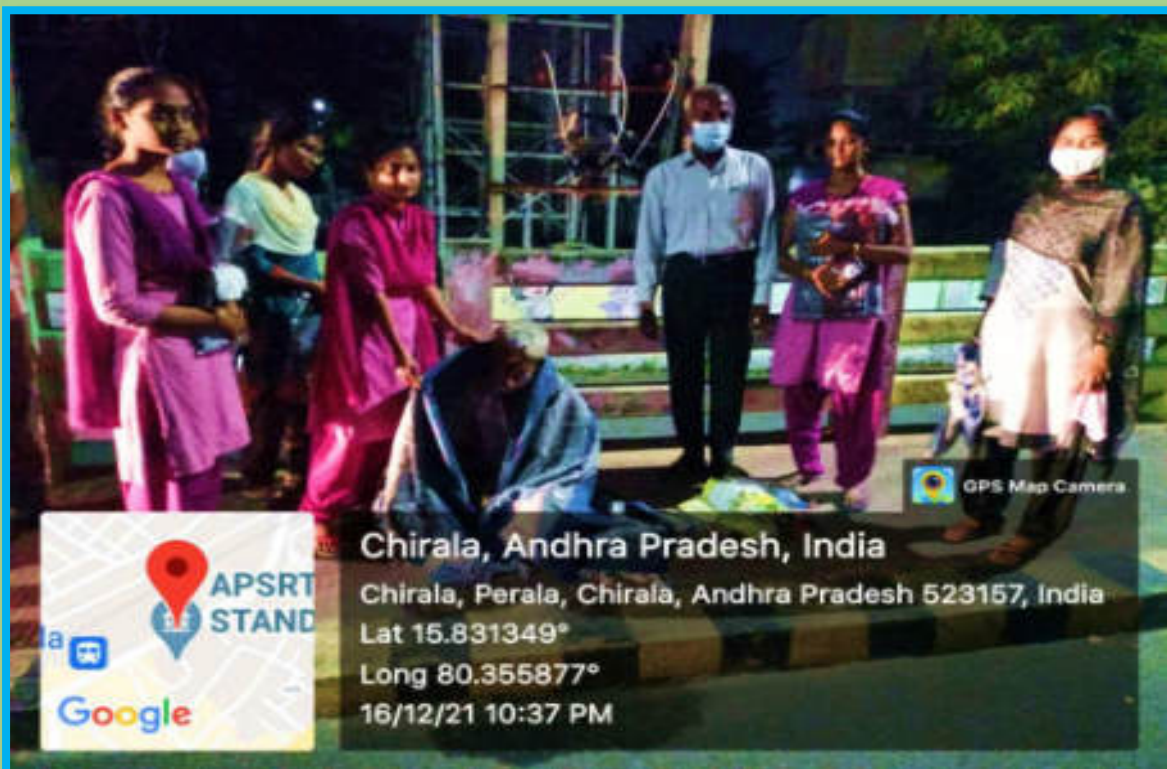

Outcome:

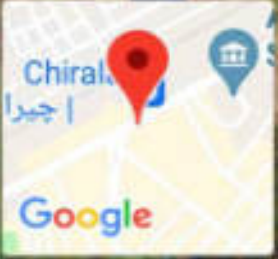

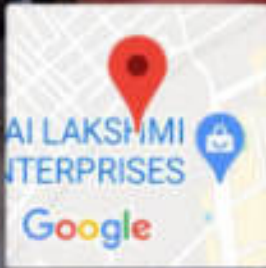

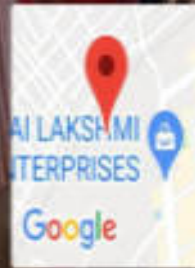
