REPORT ON "AWARENESS ON INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS"

Date:-12-08-2019

The Department of Commerce has organized the Workshop on "Awareness on Intellectual Property Rights" dated on 12-08-2019 the resource person was Sri D.Emmanuel. He spoke that IPR can be protected, for example, by registering patents, trademarks and designs. 'Intellectual Property Rights' (IPR) refers to rights of ownership of Intellectual Property. It is essential for students to know their way around Intellectual Property Rights.

In this workshop Sri D. Emmanuel explained that Intellectual property (IP) pertains to any original creation of the human intellect such as artistic, literary, technical, or scientific creation. Intellectual property rights (IPR) refers to the legal rights given to the inventor or creator to protect his invention or creation for a certain period of time. These legal rights confer an exclusive right to the inventor/creator or his assignee to fully utilize his invention/creation for a given period of time. It is very well settled that IP play a vital role in the modern economy. It has also been conclusively established that the intellectual labor associated with the innovation should be given due importance so that public good emanates from it. Later Sir explained the importance of R&D in IPR- There has been a quantum jump in research and development (R&D) costs with an associated jump in investments required for putting a new technology in the market place. The stakes of the developers of technology have become very high, and hence, the need to protect the knowledge from unlawful use has become expedient, at least for a period, that would ensure recovery of the R&D and other associated costs and adequate profits for continuous investments in R&D.

In the workshop he explained how IPR helps in business growth namely- IPR is a strong tool, to protect investments, time, money, effort invested by the inventor/creator of an IP, since it grants the inventor/creator an exclusive right for a certain period of time for use of his invention/creation. Thus IPR, in this way aids

the economic development of a country by promoting healthy competition and encouraging industrial development and economic growth.

Sri Emmanuel had explained the role of Patents in IPR- Patent act in India is more than 150 years old. The inaugural one is the 1856 Act, which is based on the British patent system and it has provided the patent term of 14 years followed by numerous acts and amendments. Brief overview of IPR with special emphasis on pharmaceuticals. Lastly Sir explained about undisclosed information in IPR- Protection of undisclosed information is least known to players of IPR and also least talked about, although it is perhaps the most important form of protection for industries, R&D institutions and other agencies dealing with IPR. Undisclosed information, generally known as trade secret or confidential information, includes formula, pattern, compilation, programme, device, method, technique, or process. Protection of undisclosed information or trade secret is not really new to humanity; at every stage of development people have evolved methods to keep important information secret, commonly by restricting the knowledge to their family members.

To conclude Sri. D.Emmanuel has shared his vast knowledge to the students and staff. The importance of the concepts in IPR and its impact in the society is clearly stated by the resource person. All the staff and students took active participation in the workshop and learnt the IPR related issues.
